The Federation invites tenders for the Bookstall concession at the above event which is to take place at Hull from 31<sup>st</sup> July – 10<sup>th</sup> August 2025.

Bids can include the sales of computers/software/chess equipment/trophies and other chess related merchandise in addition to books.

The bidder is invited to include in the tender the provision of free or discounted books for distribution as prizes by our commentator and our coach.

Your bid should be exclusive of VAT. VAT will be added as appropriate when invoiced. Any bids should be in the form of an e-mail marked clearly "Championship Bid – (Chess Merchandiser)" sent to The Congress Manager - [manager.british@englishchess.org.uk](mailto:manager.british@englishchess.org.uk) - and should arrive no later than Sunday 30<sup>th</sup> March 2025 and clearly state the terms of the prospective tender and the days when the bookstall will be provided. Any bids not received by that date may be rejected.

A sub-committee will consider each bid and will advise all parties in writing with letters or emails whether their bid has been successful. The bidding procedure is confidential, the Federation may accept/reject any bid without assigning a reason and will not enter into any correspondence relating to the bidding procedure.
